FINAL REPORT

STAKEHOLDER PARTICIPATION

344 stakeholders participated in the December 13, 2003, election. There were 3 provisional ballots which were not counted. The election was held from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm, at the Sunland-Tujunga Municipal Building, 7747 Foothill Blvd., Tujunga, CA 91042-2137.

Jerry Kvasnicka, LWVLA, met with the Elections Committee and the Coordinating Council prior to the election to clarify logistics and explain procedures for the election day. DONE staff assisted STNC and LWVLA volunteers with registration and ballot handling. Translators for Spanish and Armenian were available. The League of Women Voters of Los Angeles (LWVLA) arrived at the polling site at 12:00 pm, and reviewed the layout of the room, inquired of the eligibility of each volunteer and then secured a room for counting of the ballots.

BALLOTS

The ballot counters were volunteers from the Sunland Tujunga area, the Elections Committee, and the League of Women Voters of Los Angeles (Sunland Tujunga Unit).

There were four different ballots, each color coded to represent the four regions.

Counting commenced at 3:30 pm and was completed at 8:30 pm. An additional counting for clarification was held on Tuesday, December 16th, with the Election Administrator and 3 Election Committee members. Further clarification of totals was done by the Administrator including the addition of one ballot, which did not alter the elected candidates as announced in the preliminary results.
